Both boards engaged in strategic discussions focused on the ongoing transition process of MKRH towards full operational independence and existing and potential collaborative initiatives between the two referral hospitals.

Gen.Kibochi led a comprehensive tour of MKRH's facilities, highlighting areas of clinical and operational excellence, upcoming projects aimed at enhancing service delivery moreso, the upcoming CT scan & MRI units.

Other areas visited were the hospital wards, Farewell home and the MKRH Oxygen Plant, which currently meets the hospital's critical oxygen needs, and goes further to sell surplus oxygen to eleven (11) other hospitals in this region. Moreover, there are plans to scale up sales to generate more revenue for the hospital.

Dr. Gullet praised the hospitals management for the great work achieved more so the oxygen plant, that serves as a model initiative. The meeting marked a strong foundation for future collaboration and coordination as MKRH progresses through its transition phase.
